EXTRA SUPPORT THIS WINTER

A £170 million COVID Winter Grant Scheme became available from early December and will be run by county councils and unitary authorities, covering the period until the end of March 2021. The grant will be used to support those most in need across England with the cost of food, energy (heating, cooking, lighting) and water bills and essentials. South Staffordshire Council will be working closely with Staffordshire County Council to provide support to residents and ensure the funding meets the objectives. SHOP LOCAL

In December, you may have seen one of the new 'support local' bags on your local high street and by spending money locally, you are helping them get back up and running. These shops and businesses form the heart of our local communities and right now they need your support. CONGRATULATIONS TO SUPPORT STAFFORDSHIRE

Support Staffordshire, which supports a membership of more than 1000 voluntary, community and social enterprise (VCSE) organisations across Staffordshire won the NAVCA Heart of the Community Award for being the beating heart of the local VS and wider economy.

CHRISTMAS FOOD PARCELS

100 food parcels were delivered to retired people over the age of 60 in the district who were spending Christmas day on their own. Usually, a free Christmas lunch with all the trimmings is served up to 50 people at the South Staffordshire Council Offices in Codsall but as this was not possible due to covid restrictions and work on the Council building, organisers decided to distribute Christmas food parcels instead. Well done to all involved.

BILBROOK SCHOOL CROSSING WARDEN RETIRES

At the end of the school term in December, Charlotte, the school crossing patrol warden outside Lane Green First School & Bilbrook Middle School retired after 25 years of service to the community. She will be greatly missed. Both crossing patrol warden jobs in Bilbrook are now being advertised by Staffordshire County Council. I am working to ensure that two new wardens are employed as soon as possible.

NEW BILBROOK & CODSALL NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICE OFFICER

In December, we welcomed PC Sandy Kaur, our new neighbourhood police officer for Bilbrook and Codsall. Sandy recently joined Staffordshire Police through the Police Now Graduate Leadership Programme and is keen to get to know residents and ensure our community is safe.
