

Consultation Survey Terms and Conditions for Prize Draw

1. The prize draw is open to all Bilbrook residents who complete the Bilbrook Neighbourhood Plan Survey. Members of Bilbrook Parish Council, its Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, and any other organisation connected with the Bilbrook Neighbourhood Plan are not eligible to enter the prize draw.
2. Entry to the prize draw is by fully completing the Bilbrook Neighbourhood Plan Survey 2022 and providing contact details in the relevant section. Under 18's completing the survey must confirm that they have the permission of their parent or guardian to enter the prize draw.
3. Only one entry per person. Multiple entries will be disqualified.
4. There is one prize: £100 cash prize.
5. The prize draw closes at 23:59 on 5th May 2022 with the winner drawn by the Bilbrook Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group by 26th May 2022 using a computer programme to randomly generate a winner.
6. The winner will be notified by email by 31st May 2022 to the email address or telephone number they specified when they completed the questionnaire. If the winner does not claim the prize within 30 days of being notified then they will forfeit the prize and a re-draw will take place. To claim the prize the winner must follow the instructions in the email/telephone call notifying them that they are the winner and they will need to provide proof of being a Bilbrook resident. If an under-18 is the winner, written permission of parent or guardian will be needed to release the prize. The winner will receive their prize no later than 30 days after they claim the prize.
7. The winner is responsible for paying any income tax (if any) due on the prize won.
8. No responsibility will be accepted for incomplete or lost entries or entries not received.
